Hawkeye Harvest Food Bank

The Hawkeye Harvest Food Bank is committed to providing food assistance to individuals and families in need. The food bank is operated solely by volunteers as we have no compensated employees. We rely solely on the generosity of members of our community both monetarily and with food donations.

During the past year, the Hawkeye Harvest Food Bank provided food boxes to 3141 households, providing 92,280 meals to 7,690 individuals. The highest month of usage was June 2007 with 316 households, with the food bank providing 10,768 meals to 897 individuals. In the prior year, the highest month of utilization was August 2006 with 318 households with a total of 897 individuals being provided with 10,794 meals.

Thank you again to everyone who has helped the Hawkeye Harvest Food Bank in the past year. Your kindness and generosity is truly appreciated.
